WHO THE PROGRAM IS FOR?

The PDAL Program is for anyone who helps adults learn in the private, public, or higher education institutions. The program will help you: instruct or train adults; develop, facilitate or coordinate training or education

programs in business, industry, government, institutions or community organizations; provide support services to adult education; and design educational materials for adults.

REQUIRED COURSES

PDAL 0100 Adult Learners: Get an introduction to adult learning theory and the skills required to design and deliver adult education.

PDAL 0120 Needs Assessment: Focus on needs assessment as a powerful tool for planning programs and accomplishing desired outcomes. Includes a 6-hour applied project.

PDAL 0110 Program Design: Introduce yourself to design analysis, learning outcomes, and development of materials. Includes a 6-hour applied project.

PDAL 0130 Facilitation and Instruction: Prepare yourself to facilitate learning by creating engaging learning environments, fostering learning and assessing learning objectives. Includes a 6-hour applied project.

PDAL 0160 Program Evaluation: Gain the tools to assess the learning experience and determine whether learning objectives have been achieved. Includes a 6-hour applied project.

PDAL 0140 Technology in Learning: Explore different educational technologies and examine their potential impact on formal and informal learning. Includes a 6-hour applied project.

PDAL 0150 Diversity and Accommodation: Gain practical skills required to create maximally inclusive learning environments, and deepen understanding of responsibilities for learner accommodation. Includes a 6-hour applied project.

PDAL 0170 Applied Project: Apply theoretical and applied learning components in an individualized integrative project.
